

What Does the Qur'an and Bible Say About Isa Al Masih - Jesus the Messiah? By Karen Sue Nyquist



1. What does the Qur'an say about the Bible? The Qur'an directs us to believe the Taurat/Torah (the first 5 books of the Bible, written by Musa/Moses), Zabur/Psalms, and the Injil/Gospel, which means they have not been abrogated nor annulled. ".. for, verily, those who have attained to faith [in this divine writ], as well as those who follow the Jewish faith, and the Sabians, and the Christians - all who believe in God and the Last Day and do righteous deeds - no fear need they have, and neither shall they grieve" (Qur'an 5:68-69).

Because Isa/Jesus prophesied, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by

Because Isa/Jesus prophesied, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away" (Luke 21:33), we know that the Injil/Gospel has not been corrupted. The prophet Daud/David declared, "The words of the Lord are pure words, Like silver tried in a furnace of earth, Purified seven times. You shall keep them, O Lord, You shall preserve them from this generation forever" (Zabur/Psalms 12:6-7). God knows how to protect His Word from being corrupted!

- **2.** God has sent His prophets throughout history. Albrahim/Abraham, Musa/Moses, Dawud/David, and Isa Al Masih/Jesus the Messiah are a few of them.
 - a) A prophet prophesies or predicts future events and what he said does happen (Deuteronomy 18:17-22). Musa/Moses predicted that his people would leave slavery. (Exodus and Deuteronomy in the Taurat/Torah)
 - b) Many prophets, like Musa/Moses, demonstrate God's power through miracles, signs, and wonders. God demonstrated His power through Musa/Moses with the 10 plagues (examples: turning water into blood, sending locusts, darkness, hail, killing the first born, opening up the Red Sea (Exodus 7-12).
- 3. Isa/Jesus was a prophet of God, like Musa/Moses.
- a) Isa/Jesus prophesied His own death and resurrection. "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man (the Messiah) will be accomplished. For He will be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon. They will scourge Him and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again" (Injil/Gospel Luke 18:31-33). The prophets Isaiah and Dawud/David in the Zabur/Psalms both described Isa's/Jesus' death. Read Isaiah 53 and Psalm 22 and compare to the description of His death on the cross in the Injil/Gospel. (Luke 23:32-56).
 - b) Isa/Jesus prophesied the destruction of the Temple. "These things which you see—the days will come in which **not one stone** shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down," (Luke 21:5-6) which was done by the Romans in 70 AD.
 - c) Isa/Jesus, like Musa/Moses, did mighty miracles here are a few examples. He cast out demons (Luke 4:31-36; 11:14-23), healed many who were sick (Luke 4:38-41;8:42-48), fed 5,000 (Luke 9:10-17), raised the dead (Luke 7:11-17; Injil/Gospel John 11:1-45), walked on water (John 6:16-2); and calmed the storm at sea (Luke 8:22-25).
- **4. Yahya/John the Baptist was a prophet of God. -** "shall be outstanding among men, utterly chaste, and a Prophet from among the righteous" (Qur'an 3:39). We may read about him in the Injil/Gospel (Luke 1:5-22).
- 5. Yahya/John the Baptist declared that Isa/Jesus was more than a prophet. "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (Injil/Gospel-John 1:29)
- 6. Isa's/Jesus' birth was miraculous, without any physical relation between a man and a woman, nor between God and a woman. Maryam/Mary was a human virgin. "Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary "... And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus" (Luke 1:26-27, 31). "Then Mary said to the angel, 'How can this be, since I do not know a man?' And the angel answered and said to her, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon

you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the **Son of God**" (Luke 1:34-36). The Qur'an agrees that Maryam/Mary was a virgin. "How can I have a son when no man has touched me, neither have I been unchaste?" (Qur'an 3:47). **(To learn more about Isa/Jesus, read the iniil/gospel of Luke.)**

- 7. What did an angel of the LORD say about Isa/Jesus at His birth? "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:11).
- **8. Why would we need a Savior?** "For the wages of sin *is* death, but the gift of God *is* eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:23). "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever **believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life**. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved" (John 3:16-17).
- 9. What did Isa/Jesus say about Himself? "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life (dies) for the sheep" (John 10:11). "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father" (John 10:17-18). "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;" (John 10:27-28).
- **10. What Does Isa/Jesus say to you?** "Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls.** For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30). "Jesus said to them, '**Follow Me**,' " (Mark 1:17).

 11. Why be a follower of Isa/Jesus? Because He is the Way. "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). Isa/Jesus said, "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12). "this is indeed the Christ (Messiah), the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).
- **12. God's standard is high, none have met it.** "but as He who called you *is* holy, you also be holy in all *your* conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy'" (1 Peter 1:15). "For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," (Romans 3:22-23). We all need Isa's/Jesus' atonement for our sins. "Help us, O God of our salvation, For the glory of Your name; And deliver us, and provide atonement for our sins," (Zabur/Psalms 79:9) God provided Isa/Jesus as the propitiation *(atonement)* for our sins (1 John 2:2).
- 13. Are you considering becoming a follower of Isa/Jesus, but are not sure? Here is a suggested prayer: God of Heaven, the Creator of everything, please show me if what I am learning is true. Should I ask Isa/Jesus to be my Savior, my atonement for my sins? Should I become a follower of Him? I trust that You will show me the way. Thank you. Amen.
- 14. If you have decided, then here is a suggested prayer: Isa/Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and that You died to make atonement for my sins, then rose again. I know that you are calling me and I want to become a follower of You. Please, continue to teach me Your way. I will obey You as You lead me. I now accept you as my Lord and Savior.
